

REGULATIONS

From September 2014 every commercial driver of goods vehicles over 3.5 tonnes, or 2013 for PCV drivers, must be in possession of a DQC - Driver Qualification Card. This card provides evidence that the holder has completed the required 35 hours of Driver CPC training.

At the introduction of the Driver CPC in 2009, existing drivers were given acquired rights that allowed up until 2014 to complete the 35 hours. New drivers have to undertake the Initial CPC as part of their test. Once achieved the DQC is valid for five years by which time a further 35 hours of training must be completed to qualify for the next 5 years.

Each training course must be at least 7 hours in duration. Any training of less than 7 hours will not count towards the requirement.

7, 14 or 21 hours of Driver CPC can be obtained with our ADR initial course.

7 hours can be obtained with our Lorry Loader (HIAB) and Tachograph courses.

If you complete all of the above you will have achieved your 35 hours.
