Plant NVQ's

Option 1—On Site Assessment - OSAT

Awarded following assessment visits and monitoring in the workplace over a number of weeks.

Requirements:

- Minimum of six months' experience on category of plant
- Operating category of plant on site to be assessed
- Health and safety knowledge
- Witness testimonies completed by employer or supervisor
- On site practical assessment

Option 2—Experienced Worker Practical Assessment—EWPAR

Awarded after a practical test, discussion and verification of experience—Usually completed in one day.

Requirements

- Sufficient experience
- Witness testimonies completed by employer or supervisor
- Record of employment
- Record of qualifications, education and formal training

• Practical assessment, timed and working to industry tolerances/ specification required for an operator in the category sector

• Professional discussion



Gaining the relevant NVQ/SVQ will allow you to progress through the CITB scheme and change from a Red Trained Operator card to a Blue competent Operator card. The Red Trained operator card expires after 2 years, during this time it is expected that you gain 300 hours experience and achieve a plant operations NVQ.

If your Red Card has expired in the last 12 months, you can get an extension once you register for a NVQ .

If your Red Card Expired over 12 months ago, you need to complete both the NVQ and the technical test per category.

Under current CPCS rules; you cannot progress to a blue card without a relevant NVQ.

Option 2 is used to assess very experienced candidates who would prefer to demonstrate their competence using a one-off practical assessment as opposed to observation on site combined with portfolio building.
